Maureen is a qualified Adult Educator. Over the past 18 years she has established two national Registered Training Organisations, has developed and delivered client specific remote area training resources and continues to actively participate in community development. Why do her service to the industry stand apart from others and what makes clients seek her training courses?

- After eight years experience on a mine site with apprenticeship training Maureen moved back to the Northern Territory in search of further challenges
- Over some years she had gained experience on construction sites operating heavy machinery and developed a keen eye for skills gained in unusual circumstances
- Raised in the bush Maureen has a sound understanding of the unique circumstances surrounding training for remote areas
- All driver theory education delivered by Maureen involves driver attitudes, the development of defensive driving techniques and the basic skills needed to operate a vehicle not only in remote areas but when travelling and driving in the cities
- Maureen has put together a 5 day course on driver theory which encompasses the Australian Road Rules, basic vehicle maintenance identification, driver attitudes, drink driver strategies and the essential skill of changing a wheel
- Maureen facilitates the Drink Driver Education Program, a unique set of competencies derived for offenders within the Northern Territory, in remote and urban areas
- Group training is her speciality, generating up to 120 hours practical tuition within the vehicle with groups of students.
- Practical driver skills training includes manoeuvring the vehicle through a chicane in both forward and reverse, friction point starts, braking on dirt roads, listening to and watching vehicle performance, and determining continuing changes in hazard avoidance techniques
- In practical terms Maureen has been a qualified training facilitator working with both indigenous and non-indigenous clients in both urban and remote area situations since 1986 in the Northern Territory
